The Manager of the Control Room has said that Cllrs are welcome to visit the CCTV Room to see what they do and they will answer any questions Cllrs may have. Cllrs said they are interested in a visit.

63/19 Planning Applications:

Land at the A52 east of Ashbourne and west of Lady Hole Lane, CD3/0819/38

The application is for the roundabout on the A52. Cllrs discussed the application and the following response was agreed:

Whilst Osmaston and Yeldersley Parish Cllrs support the application: CD3/0819/38, Cllrs consider that the safety of pedestrians approaching the bus stop has not been taken into account and suggest the provision of a pavement on the westerly side between the bus stop and Ashbourne. They also suggest that a "pull in" is provided for the bus. Cllrs would also like to see the lighting plan - residents have concerns about the provision of street lighting and we would hope to allay their fears.
